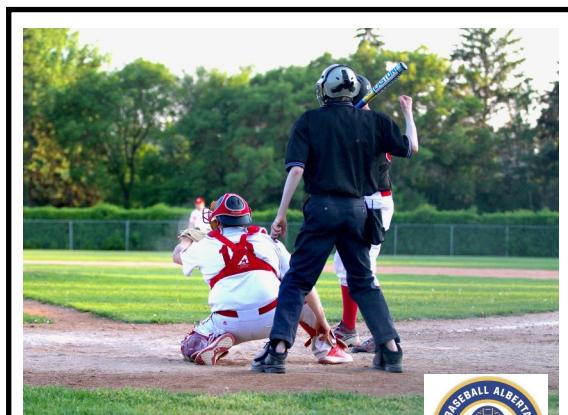
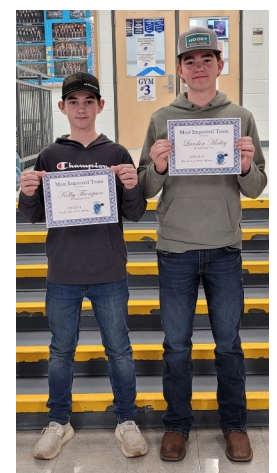


Congratulations to these Athletes!

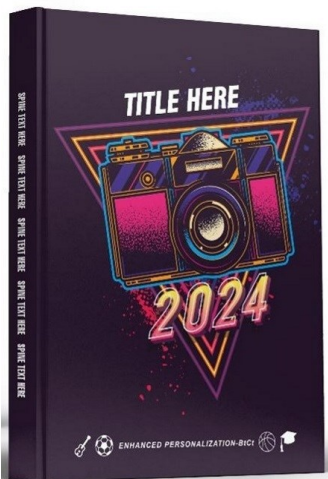


Science fun with River Watch

- Youth between the ages of 13-15 compete in an essay competition for a sponsored spot at the camp. Up to 60 kids in total from across Central and Southern Alberta will be attending the camp.
- The primary objective of this entrepreneurial-based camp is to provide youth with business training within a summer camp atmosphere.
- Throughout the week they will take part in a variety of fun workshops that will teach them the basics of business start up, market research, advertising, and business plan development.
- Daily recreational activities such as paint ball, archery, wall climbing and conquering the burma bridge and zipline
