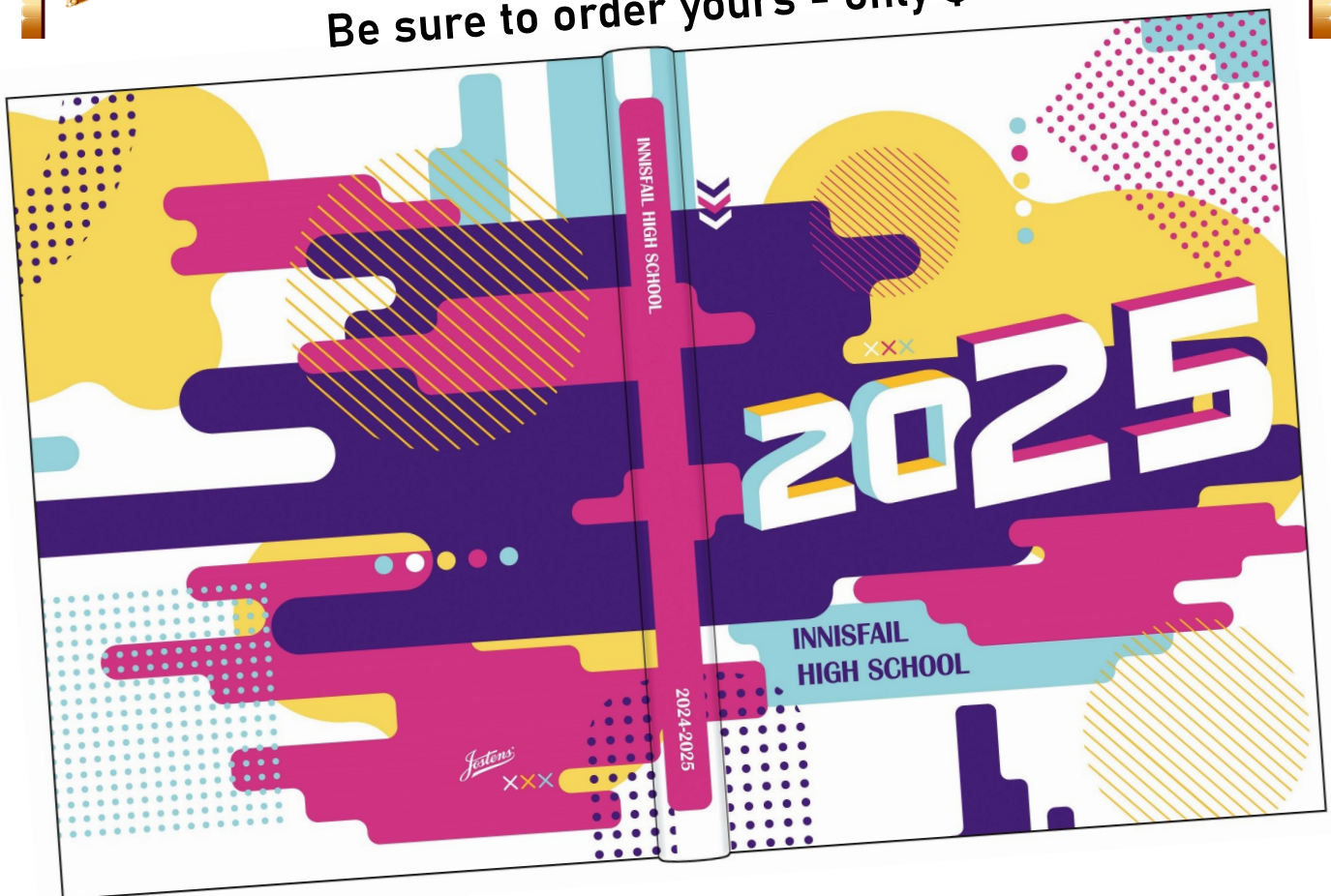


Fun Decorating for Christmas
